A recently published book "The Smartest Kids in the World: And How They Got That Way" by Amanda Ripley looks at education world-wide and what factors result in success.

She says that most exams quantify students' ability to memorise material but that it is their effectiveness at problem solving that is the important thing. She has found that schools in many countries fail to teach their students to think critically.

Apparently Poland has a very successful program which achieves this. Prior to 2000 only half of the country's rural adults would finish primary school, but the introduction of serious reforms changed that and the country's students now rank well ahead of America's in science and maths, which she says is the strongest predictor of future earnings.

Ripley has found that when high demands are made of students they mostly rise to the occasion whereas tracking students at different cognitive levels diminishes learning and boosts inequality.

She laments the "perverse sort of compassion" which prevents teachers from failing bad students, not least because this sets them up to fail in a worse way later on.

America's schools fare badly in this book but I wonder just how well Australian schools would measure up if rated in this way?

Carlisle town hall renovation uncovers 1669 debt book

As proof that things can still be found in unexpected places, a 17th century court book has been found by a workman in the clock tower attic of Carlisle's Old Town Hall, Cumbria. The 22 page book outlines 98 court cases, detailing debts of 9 August 1669. It is now being assessed and catalogued.

Handwritten poem by Poe sells for \$300,000

An original manuscript of a poem written by Edgar Allan Poe has sold for \$300,000 at an auction in Massachusetts. The handwritten 'The Conqueror Worm', with his signature, had been owned by a Rhode Island family since the 1920s. The original manuscript of the poem was thought to have been lost, and had been expected to fetch a maximum of \$20k.

Stolen rare books returned to Sweden

Two rare, stolen books have been returned to Swedish authorities during a repatriation ceremony in New York City. The two were amongst fifty-six books, of which four have been recovered, that were stolen from the National Library of Sweden in 2004 by the library's senior librarian, who sold them to collectors. The librarian committed suicide shortly after confessing to the crime.

State Library of NSW acquires the holy grail of Australiana

Two previously unknown documents which hint at 'what could have been' an alternate history of Australia have been acquired by the State Library of NSW. Known as the Queiros memorials, they are the earliest printed records relating to the discovery of Australia. Had Pedro Fernandes de Queiros, captain of the Spanish fleet, been successful in his petitions to King Philip III in 1608 and 1614 (his last) he may have found Terra Australis.

The State Library holds the pre-eminent collection of the Queiros memorials, with the latest acquisitions increasing their collection to 13. The whereabouts of the 14th memorial, the first one Queiros wrote to the king, is unknown. King Philip III did finally grant Queiros's request for an expedition, but too late. Queiros never made it to Australia, dying in 1615 before the expedition set sail.
