#### **FOREWORD**

A large villa at Herculaneum, entombed by the Mount Vesuvius eruption of AD79, and discovered in 1750, was found to have the only intact library from the Graeco-Roman world, however the scrolls were unreadable as the eruption had converted them into pitch-black blocks of carbon.

A computer scientist from the University of Kentucky has been working for two decades on the possibility of being able to read them. He had previously developed a technique to enable a digital copy of the earliest Beowulf manuscript held by the British Museum which had been previously damaged by fire.

The Vesuvius scrolls cannot be opened without them falling apart, but his methodology involves x-ray CT scans which enable the individual layers of the damaged scrolls to be effectively flattened out and read. Others are now working on this given the incentive of a US\$700,000 prize up for grabs to whoever can identify at least four separate passages of "continuous text", each at least 140 characters long, from one of the scrolls. The technique now being used employs powerful computers and machine learning software, and encouraging progress has been made.

It might well re-write history if ancient scrolls created by ancient historians can be successfully read.
