

FOREWORD

The novel "Robinson Crusoe" has been a much-read favourite since it was first published in 1719; so popular was it on its first publication that four editions were published that same year. It is supposedly based on the life of Alexander Selkirk who was cast away on a Pacific island for four years, though Crusoe was on his island for over 28 years. James Joyce wrote that Crusoe was "the true symbol of British conquest, who, cast away on a desert island, in his pocket a knife and a pipe, becomes an architect, a carpenter.." and many other things besides. His trusty savage Friday, who he rescues from cannibals, and converts to Christianity, is according to Joyce, the symbol of subject races. Karl Marx in his "Capital" critiqued Defoe's fantasy from his own different perspective, though he did say that "Crusoe's experiences are a favourite theme of political economists."

That is hardly surprising as Crusoe's real battle is against scarcity, and how he allocates the slim resources he has to survive. His is a one-man economy which economists can use as a simplified example against which more sophisticated economies can be compared.

Crusoe writes up a sort of balance sheet of debits and credits using his scarce and rapidly diminishing supply of ink. He is a lone castaway, a debit, but that he survived the shipwreck is a credit. No companion survived the wreck (debit), but he was able to salvage provisions from it (credit). There are many other items on his balance sheet.

After being rescued he goes to reclaim his plantation in Brazil and sells it. In the first six editions of the book he receives 328,000 pieces of eight (then about 72k pounds, now 5M) but in later editions a zero is removed. So did he become very rich or just middling rich? Now there's a puzzle for both economists and literary scholars!
