#### **FOREWORD**

The march of technology and the availability of online alternatives finally killed off encyclopaedias, including the once great Encyclopaedia Britan-

Previously sold door-to-door by an army of salesmen, it was discontinued as a hard copy publication in 2012. Until then it had been in continuous print since it was first published in Edinburgh, Scotland in 1768,

Some 50 years ago, prior to my being in the book trade, I was on the receiving end of the EB sales pitch. We had young children at the time and the rep was in no doubt that without the possession of a Britannica, my children's education and future prospects would be limited. The pitch was too hard sell and he left disappointed.

Later as a bookseller I acquired various editions. I still have a set of the 11th edition (1911), to which I occasionally refer. It was prized as the last edition in which acknowledged experts in various fields had made contributions. The 11th edition, by modern standards, like much else being re-considered today, was racist and sexist. There were references to "black and white races" and Marie Curie had no entry despite having won a Nobel Prize for physics. Half a century before the Holocaust it said the Anti-Semitism was "...a passing phase in the history of culture"! Yet here we are again in the 21st century when it has reared its ugly head yet again.

A writer has referred to Wikipedia as ".. a child that has eaten it parents". No doubt! It's much quicker and easier to search online rather than to wade physically through pages of information.

EB is still available on CD-ROM. I have this but have not used it much. The President of EB says that "With its scholarly, reliable reputation, Encyclopedia Britannica had not been affected by the popularity of free website Wikipedia." Wishful thinking?
