




FOREWORD

Sydney trains have recently been undertaking research into the most effective way to communicate with passengers. I've noticed lately that their station messages refer to us as "customers", which I suppose we are, but nevertheless I do prefer to be considered a "passenger".

Apparently a survey of 1,200 travellers revealed that the words "terminate" and "alight" are not readily understood by the test group, (Sydney Trains now consider these terms to be technical language) so in future they will be told that the train "ends here" and they should "get off".

Effectively they are dumbing down the language they use so make sure that more people understand their messages.

This is surely an indicator that there is something seriously wrong with our educational system. If a majority of those surveyed did not understand the meaning of quite basic English words, then there is a problem.


I wonder how many of those surveyed would be able to read a book of middling complexity, or in fact read anything at all, even newspapers.

I can understand that someone who has come here from a different couture, and whose first language is not English may have issues, but surely the answer is in education and learning the terms used in different situations. In my travels overseas I haven't found that train messages anywhere are dumbed down to take account of my struggle with unfamiliar languages.
