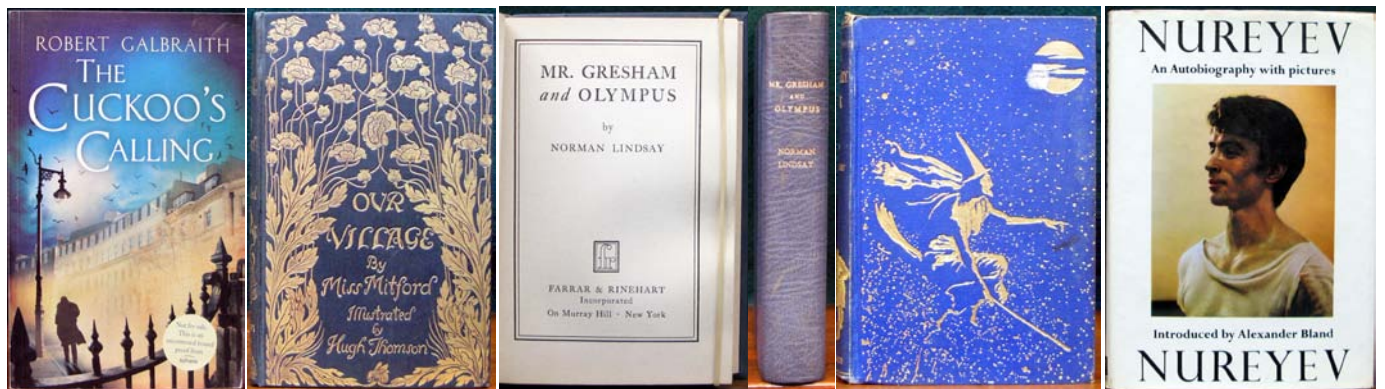
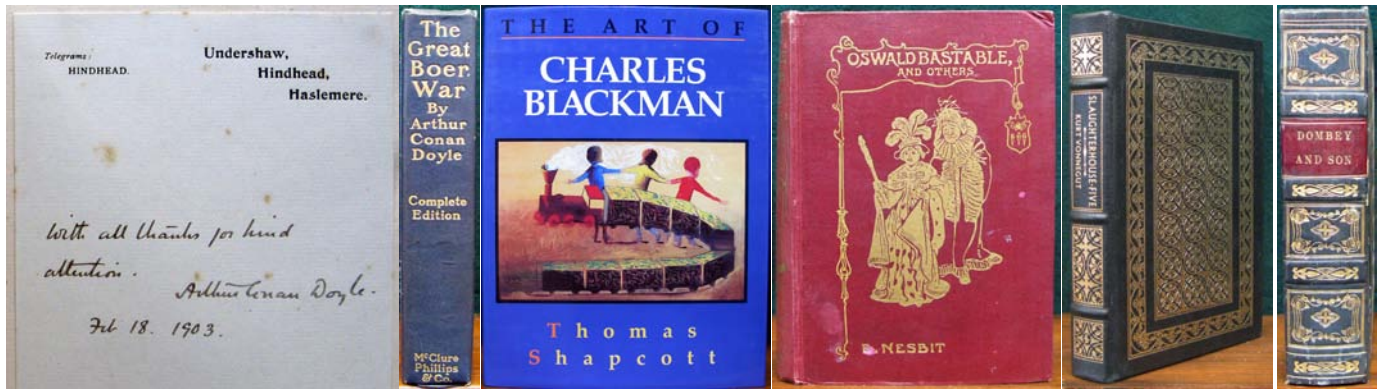

FOREWORD

The number of electric vehicles on the roads seems to be slowly increasing but not to the extent that the industry would wish or that the government would wish given their race to "net zero"

While it is commendable that people are using them, the anomaly is that almost everyone using them is charging them with electricity generated from coal-fired power stations, which is hardly a "green" situation nor will it help us reach "net zero". This is unlikely to change in the immediate future, given that the life of some of older power stations is being extended as renewables are not coming on line fast enough.

I saw Dick Smith speaking about this recently. He said he purchased a Nissan Leaf EV 10 years ago and while he was happy with it he wanted to charge it with a renewable energy source so had solar panels fitted on his house and a battery installed there to store the energy generated. He has used it this way for 10 years but recently had to replace both the car battery and the storage battery at a cost of \$10,000 each. He has kept a careful tally of costs and said, taking all costs into account, he calculated that over the period it has actually cost him double what he would have expended had he purchased a Nissan Leaf petrol vehicle at the same time.

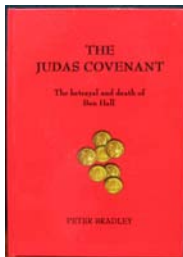
His conclusion was that to run an EV in a truly green manner at the moment, a person needed to be wealthy!

Most EV owners carry on about how much they save because they no longer have to purchase petrol, but don't take into account all the other costs. Insurance companies are now awake to the risks involved with the charging of lithium-ion batteries, and as a result many apartment body corporates don't allow them to be charged in their buildings, forcing EV owners onto the streets looking for charging points.

We are being urged to upgrade to the latest vehicle technology long before the infrastructure to properly support it is in place!
