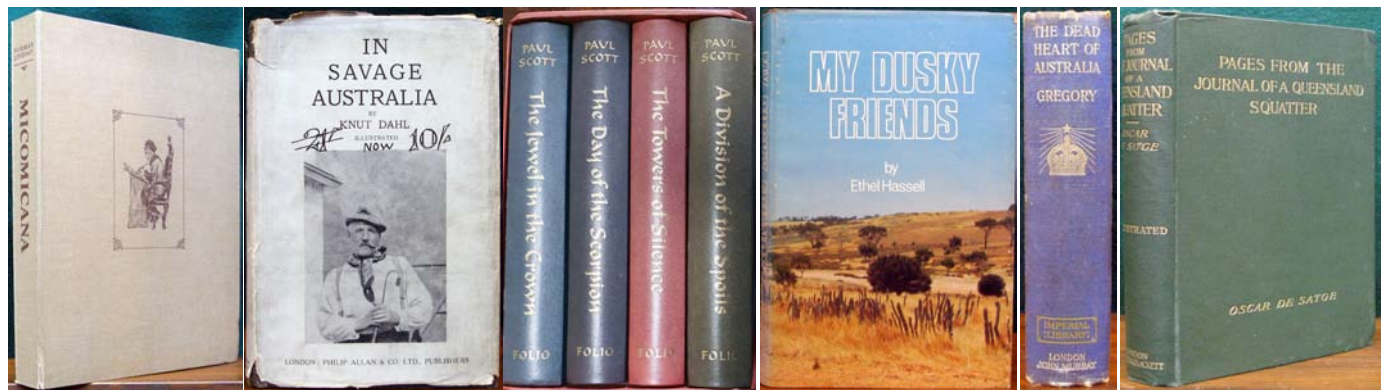
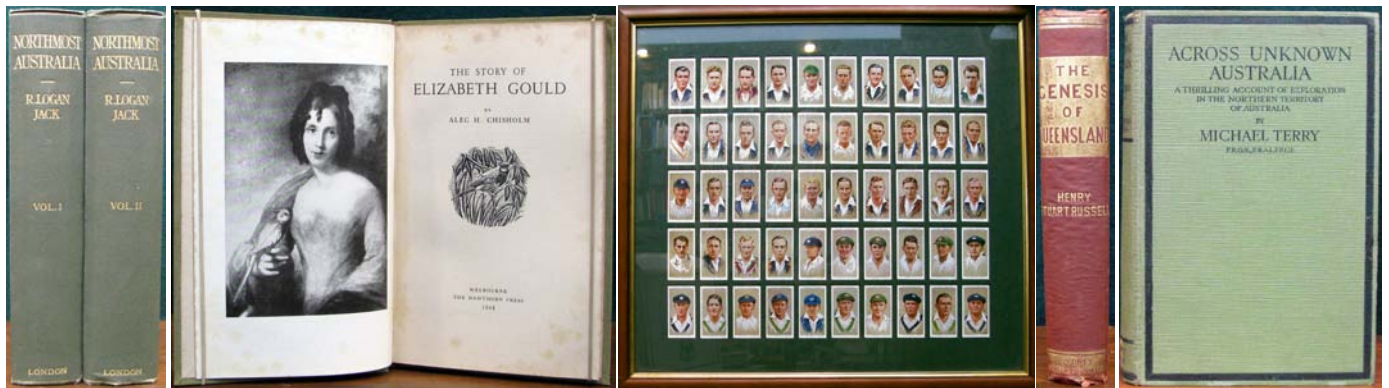

FOREWORD

Many fine Australian plays have been written which explore universal themes of love, friendship, change, the passage of time, violence, corruption, and social dynamics in typical Australian settings..

A particularly iconic play is "The Summer of the Seventeenth Doll" written by Ray Lawler, who recently passed away at 103, and who played the role of Barney in the first production in 1955.

The play involves cane cutters Roo and Barney who travel to Melbourne every year in the lay-off period to meet up with their girlfriends. Every year Barney buys his girlfriend a kewpie doll, but on the seventeenth occasion, it all goes wrong due to the changing dynamics of their lives. There was an American film of the play in which Barney was played by Ernest Borgnine.

"The One Day of the Year" is a play by Australian playwright Alan Seymour, first performed in 1960. It's set in post-World War II Australia and revolves around the complex relationships within a working-class family, focusing on the tension between the father, a veteran of the war who takes great pride in Anzac Day, and his son, who is critical of the way the day is celebrated. The son's modern, more critical perspective clashes with his father's traditional views, creating a conflict that highlights generational and ideological divides.

"Don's Party", a play by Australian playwright David Williamson and first performed in 1971, is a sharp social commentary set in the 1960s, focusing on a group of middle-class Australians who gather for a party to watch the results of the 1969 federal election, a favourite and typical Australian activity on election nights. The interactions between the guests highlight themes of political and social change, as well as the challenges and contradictions of contemporary Australian life.

There are many other plays of course and Australian playwrights will continue to challenge and entertain us with powerful works that explore current issues.
