



FOREWORD

Over my more than four decades as a bookseller, I have seen many collecting tastes and fashions come and go.

In the late 70's and early 80's Australian inland exploration was very popular and collectors were buying up anything they could find in good condition, so prices rose appropriately. Towards the end of the 80's with the Bicentennial approaching, First Fleet books were all the rage. The journals of Phillip, Hunter, White & Tench were highly sought after. I had a client who agreed to buy any of these journals I could acquire for him as he expected that at the moment of the Bicentenary he would cash in on the price rises he expected to happen then. Prices rose in expectation, but started to diminish once the event happened, though not the importance of those volumes.

Accounts of voyages, and particularly those of James Cook, are having a bad rap at the moment due to the perception that the English colonisers, were evil in displacing the indigenous inhabitants and stealing their land. The reality is considerably more nuanced but public perception and the education system plays a large part in forming society's views. I believe that this view will change in time, though I may not be around to see it.

Poetry is one area where I have seen demand largely disappear. I used to sell a lot of poetry, but no longer do, and many mainstream publishers no longer publish poetry. The older bush poets, Paterson and Lawson no longer seem to speak to the younger generation, and the most recent Australian poet of note was Les Murray, sadly now gone. I heard Les recite his poetry to an audience on several occasions and it was an joyous experience. His immense pleasure in the reading and the audience response shed new light on his poetry. I think poetry is meant to be read aloud rather than just read on the page, though Les published over 30 highly successful volumes.

"We bring nothing into this world | except our gradual ability | to create it, out of all that vanishes | and all that will outlast us." Les Murray.
